GET INSPIRED! ...some HIKES & WALKS in the MONFERRATO HILLS AREA

1

IN THE RUCHE' WINE LANDS Montemagno (AT) - 13 km height difference 280 m

Crossing the village of Montemagno the route leads us to immerse ourselves in the nature of the most beautiful hills of Monferrato and to get to know its peculiarities. We are in the Ruchè wine lands, the smallest DOCG of Monferrato area.

We'll also enjoy the view from one of the famous "Big Bench".

UNESCO VINEYARD LANDSCAPES Cella Monte (AL) - 12 km or 7 km height difference 250 m or 150 m

Hike among the rolling hills in the UNESCO vineyard landscapes, the "Land Art" of the territory, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy and the visit of a characteristic "infernot", underground rooms, dug in the "Pietra da Cantoni" (a sandstone typical of this area) used to preserve the best vintages, as temperature and humidity remain constant throughout the year, an example of tradition in Monferrato area.

IN THE "SEA" OF ROLLING HILLS Grazzano Badoglio (AT) - 11 km height difference 200 m

Hiking totally immersed in the "sea" of Monferrato rolling hills:

a Big Bench symbol of love and history of Monferrato; the land of Malvasia wine and its symbol, the "double tree of happiness" ("Bialbero della Felicità"), a cherry tree upon a mulberry tree; nature and relax in these postcard-like panoramas.

NOT JUST ABOUT VINEYARDS Camagna Monferrato (AL) - 12 km height difference 300 m

Hike through the countryside discovering the biodiversity in Monferrato area, a "lavender scented" Big Bench, stunning views, fun facts and visit of "Infernot" (*upon availability of the property).

TRADITION & PANORAMA Rosignano Monferrato (AL) - 12 km height difference 300 m

A perched and gorgeous village, rich in tradition, in the past sentinel of the Monferrato area and its hamlets. We'll enjoy breathtaking views, we'll see from the distance the old quarries of "Pietra da Cantoni", we'll cross the Ghenza valley, keeper of the white truffle and we'll reach the Big Bench "Rosso Grignolino".

VINEYARDS AND OLIVE GROVES Olivola (AL) - 7 km height difference 280 m

Olivola...an amazing surprise in the heart of UNESCO site.

Starting from the small village, UNESCO "core zone", the route leads us through vineyards and countryside, to discover a Big Bench nestled in an olive grove and stories shrouded in mystery.

MONFERRATO SUNSET HIKE Grana Monferrato (AT) - 3, 6 or 8 km height difference 50 or 100 m

Hiking at sunset through vineyards and nature, enjoying a breathtaking and relaxing panorama in the Ruchè wine area, discovering about the story of the smallest DOCG of the territory.

INFERNOT SUNSET HIKE Cella Monte (AL) - 3 or 7 km height difference 50 or 150 m

Hike on paved and dirt roads immersing ourselves in the vineyards at sunset. We'll enjoy the view from one of the most beautiful hill in Monferrato and we'll walk through one of the most beautiful villages in Italy!

MONFERRATO PANORAMA Casorzo Monferrato (AT) - 9 km height difference 100 m

Easy and panoramic hike between the provinces of Alessandria and Asti. Relax in nature, tales and stories of an authentic land, home of the Malvasia wine.

BIG BENCH EXPERIENCE Lu Monferrato (AL) - 24 km height difference 400 m

Hike reaching 4 Big Benches and listening to Land Art's stories... From the american designer Chris Bangle comes the "Big Bench Community Project" (BBCP) initiative, to support local enterprise, tourism and craftsmanship in the places that host these out-of-scale installations. Amazing panoramas will frame our long hike!
